

# APRIL BIBLE READING PLAN

This month we're venturing into the epistles! Together we will be looking at four of the letters that Paul wrote.

We start our journey by looking at Paul's two letters to the church of the Thessalonians where we'll see that following Jesus produces a counter-cultural way of life as the church is called to focus on holiness, love and future hope.

We then turn to Paul's first letter to Timothy and read about the holistic vision of the nature and mission of the church.

Finally, we'll read Paul's letter to Philemon where, in light of the gospel, we see that Jesus' family is a new humanity of equal partners, which Paul uses to make a big ask of his friend.

Alongside this, we continue our daily walk through the Psalms. Enjoy the journey with us!
